Grad Expectations

We expect our grad class to be leaders in the school / community and set good examples with the choices they make. Grade 12 students who choose, in their final year, to attend school or school events having consumed drugs or alcohol may not be allowed to take part in school-based grad activities including the Grad Dinner and Dance (Prom).

Assemblies & Forms

Throughout the year there will be a number of grad assemblies where students will be given information towards graduation including PSI, transcript verification, post-secondary choice

Grad Photos

Grad photos are separate from the regular school photos and will occur **January 14-22** in the afternoon & evening (after classes). Students can sign-up for a sitting starting in early January ONLINE. Students who only want a photo to appear in the yearbook and do not want proofs etc. do not have to pay the sitting fee. All grads **must** have their photo taken by the Vibrant Photos for inclusion in the yearbook, grad composite and grad convocation slideshow.

Retakes will be available **(February 11)** for those students who missed the original session or who received photos that they are not satisfied with.

The grad fee is \$65 and must be paid before you pick up your gown which covers the cost of the ceremonies, cap & gown, two tickets to Convocation, grad BBQ, grad folder (with personal photo & school leaving certificate). Grad Financial Aid

Grad Convocation

The Ceremony

If you have completed the requirements necessary to graduate, you will be participating in the Grad Ceremony. Students may participate in the graduation ceremonies only if they are taking a course of studies that satisfy the provincial graduation requirements by May 14th. Students enrolled in courses outside of Abby Senior that are required for graduation must be 80% complete to be eligible to take part in the ceremony. If you are not sure if you have completed the requirements, please see your counselor. In addition, all students meeting the required number of course credits to graduate students must be in good standing in their current courses. This includes the completion of grad transition and work experience booklets. Grad fee of \$65-- please pay online.

Grad Valedictorian/ Grad Speaker

The Valedictorian and Grad Speaker are members of the graduating class who speaks on behalf of all graduates at the Grad Ceremonies. This honour is usually bestowed on an outstanding student of the graduating class. The Valedictorian is chosen by a staff committee and represents all qualities that we value at ASSS: Character, Academic Achievement, Extracurricular Involvement and Community Service. In addition, students may nominate themselves or one of their Grad classmates for Grad Speaker. All nominations must have a staff reference. A staff committee will review all nominations to ensure candidates for Grad Speaker meet the requirements (B or higher GPA, good conduct, good citizenship, has made significant contributions to the school, has staff reference(s)). These TWO individuals will be the Grad Valedictorian and Grad Speaker and will address their Grad Class at Convocation.

Grad Gowns

Students will receive a gown, stole, cap and **Grad 2027** tassel. The Grad Gown / Stole/ Cap/ Tassel is **yours to keep** – enjoy your souvenir. Cap & Gown Distribution will occur the week of June 14th as part of the Grad BBQ. All fees must be paid to pick up your Cap & Gown.

Convocation Tickets

Two tickets to Convocation are included in the Graduation Fee, however, additional tickets are \$10.00 and can be purchased by cash only in the office. You can only pick up your tickets if you have paid your \$65 Grad Fee and have no outstanding school fees. Your tickets will be handed out when you pick up your Cap & Gown. There will be many tickets available.

Grad Stage Crossing Quotes

Your grad stage crossing quote is read as you cross the stage during grad ceremonies. As grad ceremonies are a formal occasion for your parents in celebration of your achievements, you may thank your parents, acknowledge support, include a meaningful quote etc.

Check with Mrs. Doan for final day to submit

Your stage crossing quote is written by you and will be read out loud (by a staff member) as you cross the stage during Grad Ceremonies. It is your chance to give a short statement to your parents, teachers and fellow grads regarding you, your education or your future.

Topics you might include are:

- Plans after you leave Abby
- What you enjoyed most about Abby
- A fond memory, a quote, a favourite saying
- Long term goals

For example: Serge would like to thank all of his coaches, teachers and fellow students who made Abby a fun place to be! Rugby rocked and Drama rolled. Serge plans to attend UFV next year.

Rules:

- Write your introduction in third person and do not use “I”
- No longer than three sentences of approximately 30 words or less
- If you do not submit an introduction – only your name will be announced as you cross the stage.

Grand March

Parents will delight in this activity as we ask parents to assemble in the gym, sit in the bleachers and take pictures of the entire grad class as they enter the historic Pit Gym then march to their selection of songs and show off their tuxedos and dresses.

Prom Dinner & Dance

Prom is a formal event where students get to dress up and spend a very memorable night together. Grads will share a beautiful buffet dinner and dance the night away. Abby will be going out of district this year to a fabulous setting at **Newlands Golf Course**. All grads and their dates **MUST** travel by bus (supplied by the school) to the venue as per district policy. We must confirm numbers as of **Friday, May 28th**. Newlands Golf Course (Langley)

Grad Prom is a special event intended to celebrate our graduating students. Students wishing to bring a guest who is not a member of the graduating class must follow the school's guest application process.

The following criteria apply to all Grad Prom guest requests:

- **All guests must be approved by school administration.** Submission of a guest application does not guarantee approval.
- **Guest applications will be considered in the order in which completed applications are received.** Approval may also be subject to venue capacity and other event considerations.
- **Guests must receive approval before a prom ticket is purchased.** Tickets purchased for an unapproved guest will not result in guest approval.
- **Guest applications will only be accepted for students who are currently in Grade 11 or Grade 12 and who are 18 years of age or younger.**
- Students are responsible for ensuring that their guest understands and follows all school expectations and event guidelines.

These criteria are intended to support a safe, respectful, and appropriately supervised Grad Prom while ensuring that graduating students are able to celebrate this important milestone with their school community
